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
Dear Parents Families and Friends

Opal Card

A reminder to students that at the start of each bus trip, it is important to tap on by placing your opal card on the opal card reader. 
Medical Alert

There have been a number of cases of gastroenteritis and impetigo (school sores) reported.

As both these are highly contagious we ask that children remain away from school to avoid the spread of illness.

We ask that the return of students with Impetigo be accompanied with a clearance letter from the prescribing Doctor.

Students with Gastroenteritis are asked not to attend school for 48 hours after last vomit / loose bowel motion.

MAI Assessment

Last Wednesday and Thursday our Kindergarten and Year 1 students visited the school for their Mathematical Assessment Interview (MAI) with their class Teacher.

All other students in the school will be assessed with the MAI, but this will be carried out during class time over the next 3~4 weeks. The data we gather will inform us regarding the level of achievement of your child in the domains of Counting, Place Value, Addition / Subtraction and Multiplication / Division. This data will be used to determine what learning plan is required for your child.


