

At Home Numeracy Challenge

Race to 100

This card game is a fun way to practice addition. Compete for the highest score as you flip over cards. Add up your cards until you reach 100 points. The first one there wins!

Ready for a challenge? Check out the variations at the bottom of the page!

Skills:

Addition

Subtraction (see variations)

What You Need:

Deck of cards

Pencil and paper for every player (to add up scores)

What You Do:

- 1. Place a well shuffled deck of cards, face down, in the centre of the playing area.
- 2. Each player begins by drawing one card and placing it face up in front of themselves. Players write the value of this card down at the top of their papers. (Aces are worth 1, and face cards are all 10.)
- 3. When all players are ready, everyone draws a second card. They add the value of these cards to their totals.
- 4. Keep playing until one player reaches 100.

Variations:

Play until the deck runs out. The player closest to 100, without going over, wins. Add jokers into the deck. If a player draws a joker, their score drops back to zero. Start with 100 points, and subtract your way to the finish (Race to Zero). Need a challenge? Use multiplication to reach 1000 (great for Yr 4 upwards).


