Opal Cards

School student applications for 2019 are open from Monday, 15th October 2018.

Students progressing to Year 3 and Year 7 **do not** need to re-apply **if** they

- are continuing at the same school
- are residing at the same address
- have not been sent an expiry notification from Transport for NSW.

Where a student meets the new distance eligibility, the system will automatically update their entitlement. If they do not meet the new eligibility, they will receive an expiry notification.

If students need to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to <u>https://</u> apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails

Applications need to be submitted before 31st December 2018 to ensure student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card is not cancelled. If their application is submitted after 31st of December 2018, the system will automatically cancel a card and a new one will need to be issued.
